



**Parking Instructions:**

SASO team members have been instructed to park in student lots and walk swimmers to and from the pool. The closest student lots are #5 and the East Lot near the soccer and softball fields. From lot #5, walk through the Faculty/Staff lot to the pool. From the East Lot, cut through the walkway between the soccer and softball fields. Parking permits are required everywhere on campus. *Alternative parking and drop-off/pick-up options are done at your own risk.*

\*Semester parking permits can be purchased at a discounted fee of \$10 from the Community Services Office.

**Parking Information from Solano Community College Police Department:**

Parking permits are required each semester, including Summer.

**Semester Parking Permits:** Parking Permits for one semester can be purchased online here, [SCC Parking Permit Payment/Order Site](#). Permits purchased online will be mailed. After purchase, there should be a link to download a temporary parking permit that is valid for two weeks. Fall and Spring Parking Permit fees are \$20; Summer session \$6. Motorcycles do not require Parking Permits, but must be parked in designated motorcycle areas marked in yellow.

**Daily Parking Permits:** If a student prefers not to purchase a semester permit, he/she may purchase a daily permit from dispensers located in each student lot for \$1/daily (4 quarters). Parking fees are subject to change.

**ALL PERMITS MUST BE CLEARLY DISPLAYED TO BE VALID.**

Parking is free on the weekends and on District holidays. We do, however, continue to enforce employee lots, handicap, red zones, etc.

**Main Campus:** Parking for students is provided in clearly designated areas in Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6. Thirty-minute free visitor parking is in a designated area in Student Parking Lot 1. **STUDENTS ARE PROHIBITED FROM PARKING IN STAFF LOTS.** Spaces for handicapped persons are available. Parking and traffic regulations are enforced by the Solano College Police Department.
